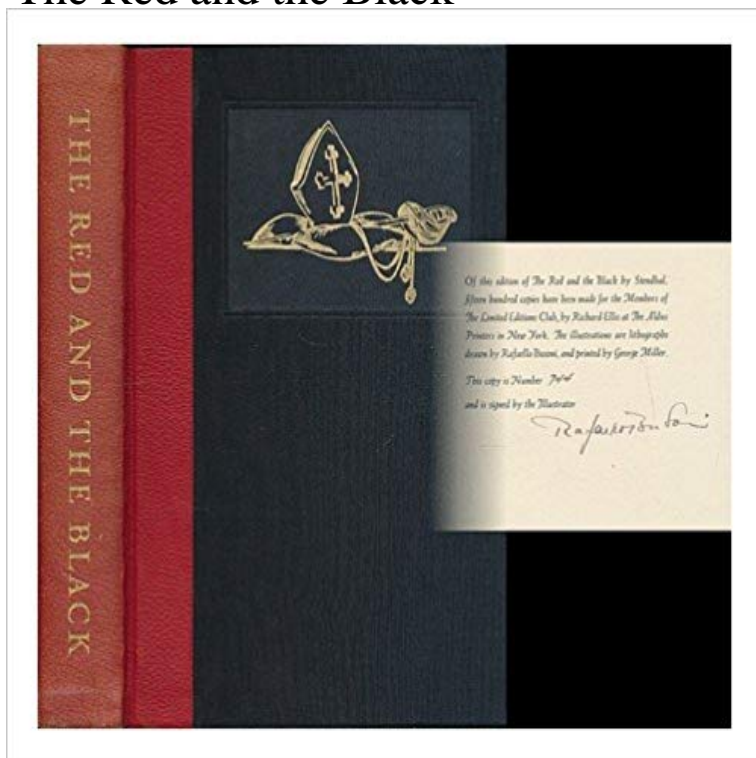


## The Red and the Black
