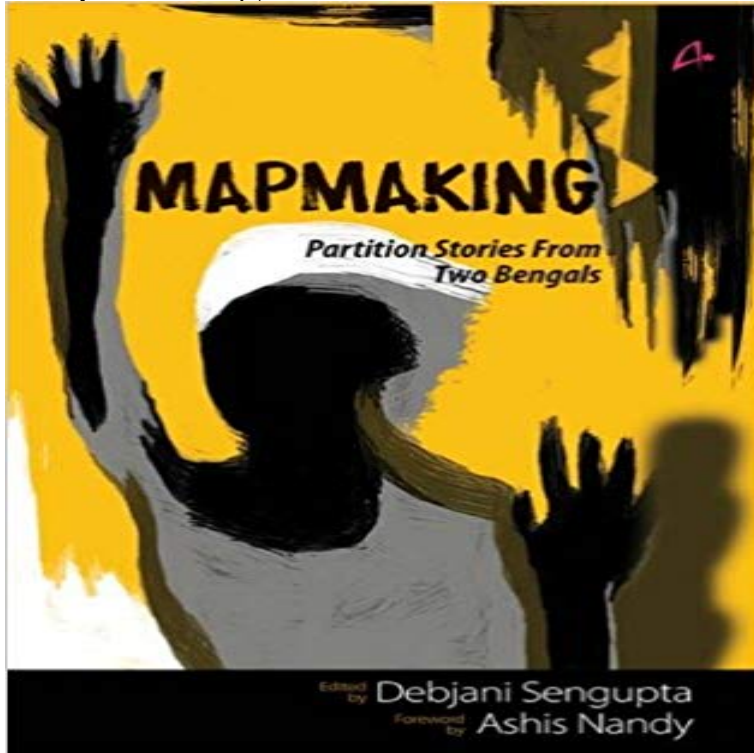


Map Making: Partition Stories from Two Bengals
