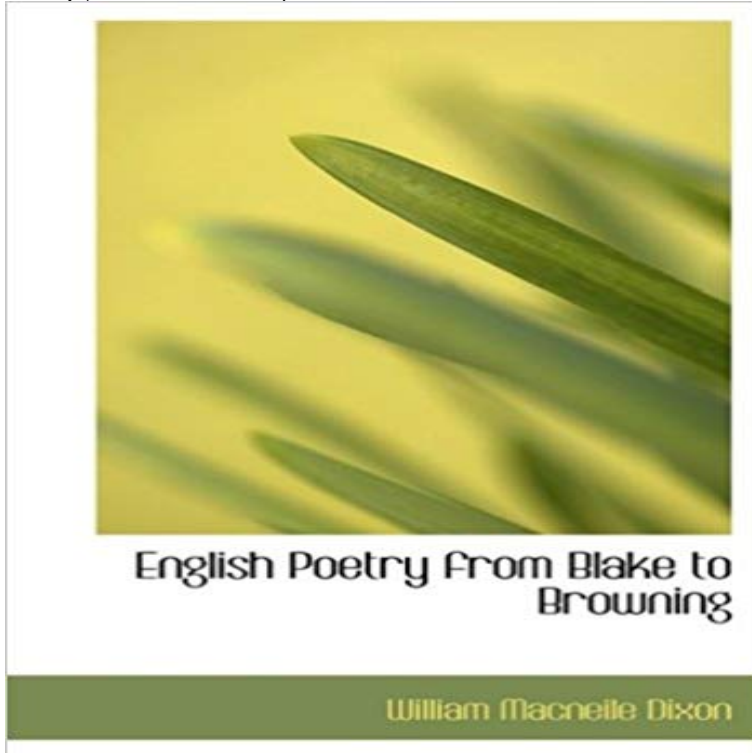


English Poetry from Blake to Browning (Large Print Edition)
