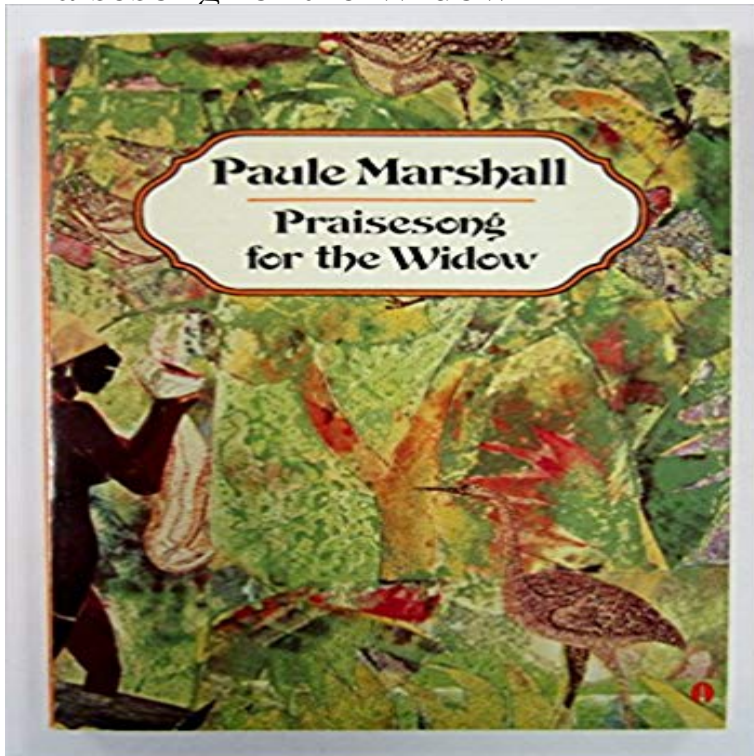


Praisesong for the Widow
